

# LOCAL RULES

To be read in conjunction with Rules of Golf and the Local Rules Board.

## **OUT OF BOUNDS** – Rule 18.2

- All ground beyond the club's boundary fence is Out of Bounds. (White stakes with black tops).
- A ball coming to rest on or beyond the road between the 10th and 11th holes is out of bounds, even if it comes to rest on another part of the course that is in bounds for other holes.

## **ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS** – Rule 16.1

### **GROUND UNDER REPAIR**

Relief may be taken:

- Washaways in bunkers, drains from bunkers, exposed cloth in bunkers.
- Wheel Ruts – in the General Area, wheel ruts made by a mower, tractor or motor vehicle.

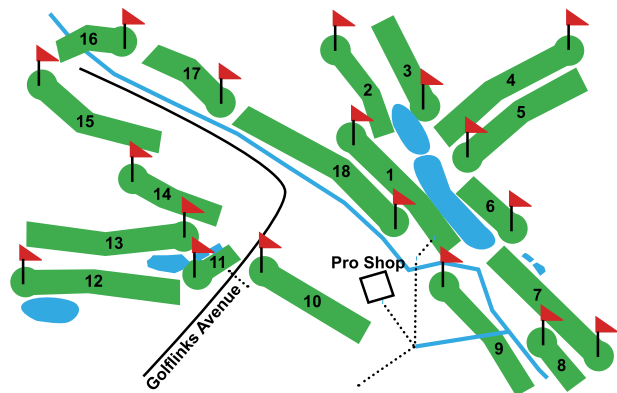
Relief must be taken:

- GARDEN BEDS - All garden beds are NO PLAY ZONES.
- TREES AND SHRUBS - Staked trees, staked shrubs and trees/shrubs under two club lengths in height are NO PLAY ZONES and are ground under repair (the GUR includes the stake and any wrapping).

### **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS**

- STAKES - All stakes are immovable obstructions.
  - ARTIFICIALLY SURFACED ROAD OR PATH - Any path or road which has any foreign material e.g. Concrete, tar, gravel, wood chips etc is an obstruction.
  - SPRINKLER HEADS – If your ball lies within 2 club lengths of the green and a sprinkler head interferes with your line to the hole, you may take relief. Ball MUST be dropped
- Penalty for breach of local rule is the General penalty.

(Loss of hole in match play or two penalty strokes in stroke play.)
